Thank you to our families, staff, volunteers and our wonderful children for your contribution towards making Book Week a great success.

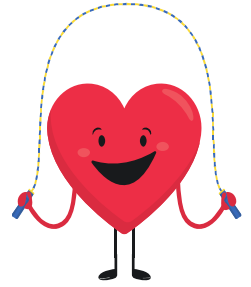


Jump Rope for Heart

VEX IQ – Collie Preston Interschool Robotics Competition

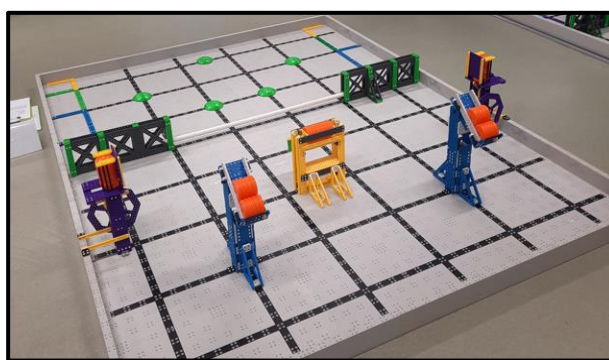
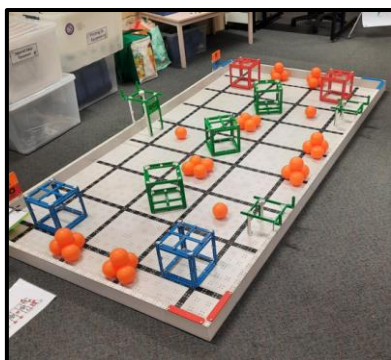
Boyanup wins robotics competition for the first time.


