Before School Procedure

To ensure students are safe and sufficiently supervised at school, we have implemented the following procedures for the beginning of each school day.

- School gates will be open from 8.15am.
- Students from Years 1-6 must take their schoolbag to the bag rack outside of their classroom and move to the basketball court or undercover area immediately.
- Basketballs and skipping ropes will be available for the students to use.
- A teacher in charge will supervise the students.
- At 8.30am, all students will be directed to class where they must access the daily timetable displayed by classroom teacher.
- ECC (Early Childhood Centre) students remain with their parents, using our seating out the front, until ECC gates open at 8.30am.
